CONNECTICUT

Cheshire: The Canal Trail in Cheshire & Hamden: Go West on Route 42 from Route 10 in Cheshire to the Lock 12 park and parking lot. The trail is 5.4 miles long and is being extended toward the South. Very busy on beautiful days, but generally very enjoyable. There are more parking lots along the trail. -*Karl Audenaerde*

West Hartford: The M.D.C. Reservoir in West Hartford, CT., on Farmington Ave, (Rte 4) about 4.5 miles out of downtown Hartford, has a nice asphalt hilly loop that is a little more than 5k. The route has a couple of variations and should be done counterclockwise to avoid a very steep downhill section. This area is closed to automobiles. Enter at the main gate and bear left after the buildings to find the parking area.

Beautiful loop around the lakes! For those of you on the Terra skis, there are many longer dirt roads, but on these some sections are too rocky to ski.
