VIRGINIA

Centreville: Bull Run Regional Park is smooth asphalt roads. Most of the time cars are scarce.

Northern Virginia: I usually roller ski on the Old Dominion and Washington Trail Regional Park, which is an old railway paved and maintained by the state. It goes for about forty miles from Arlington through Falls Church, Vienna, Reston, Herndon and Leesburg to Purcellville. The surface is reasonably maintained, new crossings get bridges built, and the area is scenic, although is being developed rapidly. In addition, there are a few water fountains along the way, as well as vending machines at the "Smiths Switch Station" between Reston and Leesburg. This trail is used by the Washington areas bicyclists, roller skaters, joggers and some stray walkers & there is a parallel horse trail.
